

## Controlling Speed Helps Control Accidents!

Many accidents involve speeding, or traveling too fast for road conditions. When transporting clients, it is highly recommended that you travel at least 5 mph below the posted speed limit. Here's one good reason why.

Researchers at the Monash University Accident Research Center conducted a simulated test. They found that when a child darted in front of a car traveling 30 mph, the car was able to stop suddenly.
