

## Drive Safely this Winter

Driving on snow-covered roads can be extremely hazardous. Advance Auto Parts provides these tips for safe driving:

- Make sure your seat is adjusted so you can easily reach and use all controls.
- Place hands in the 9:00 and 3:00 positions on the steering wheel. Use small, slow movements to steer on snow and ice.
- When braking, don't panic. The wheels can lock, causing you to skid. Gentle on-and-off use of brakes allows the tires to grip.
- If you skid, steer in the direction of the skid and accelerate gently.
- Slow down before cornering to prevent under-steering, which occurs when the car turns too little. This is common on front-wheel drive vehicles.
